The delegation was funded by Quezon City government and was implemented through Quezon City Street Soccer Local Organizing Committee;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City-Leyte Association of Organized Sports Football Club represented the Philippines in the 2019 Gothia Cup China along with the Valenzuela City-Leyte Association of Organized Sports Football club wherein they won a gold medal in the Boys 13 Playoff B Category;

WHEREAS, the 2019 Gothia Cup China was held in Qingdao, China from August 10 to 16, 2019. This prestigious tournament is considered the largest youth football tournament in Asia, bringing together 340 countries;
