*WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government has partnered with Manila Water Foundation, Inc. for the construction, installation, and rehabilitation of handwash facilities to be donated in favor of the City Government;*

*WHEREAS, Kapit Bisig Vendors Association is a duly accredited Non-Governmental Association/ Peoples Organization pursuant to City Ordinance No. SP-2862, S-2019 as certified by the Barangay and Community Relations Department (BCRD);*

WHEREAS, the donated handwashing facilities to be installed at the "Talipapa" within the Quezon City Hall Compound will be turned over to the Kapit Bisig Vendors Association. The latter shall be responsible for the upkeep and cleanliness of the hand washing facilities and its surroundings. Further, the association shall be responsible for the payment of water consumption of the hand wash facility;


WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 22 (c) and Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Kapit Bisig Vendors Association for the Maintenance and Upkeep of Handwash Facilities to be located at the "Talipapa" within the Quezon City Hall Compound.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of the subject Memorandum of Agreement shall form an integral part of this Resolution.
