*A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE ACTION OF THE QUEZON CITY UNIVERSITY BOARD OF REGENTS TO EXTEND THE CONTRACT PERIOD OF ALL ITS CONTRACTS OF SERVICE FACULTY MEMBERS UNTIL JULY 31, 2021.*

*WHEREAS, on March 15, 2021, the Contracts of Service of faculty members of the Quezon City University have expired consistent with the closing of the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of Academic Year 2020-2021;*

*WHEREAS, there are about one hundred eighty (180) full-time and part-time Contracts of Service faculty members of the University whose services need to be on board before the start of the second semester on March 22, 2021;*

*WHEREAS, the renewal process will require the Contracts of Services faculty members to physically submit various documents such as Personal Data Sheets, Drug tests, and NBI Clearance, as well as to be physically present for the notarization of documents and taking of Oath of Office in the Human Resource Department;*

*WHEREAS, starting 1<sup>st</sup> week of March this year, the number of COVID-19 cases in Quezon City has been increasing almost exponentially and requiring these Contracts of Service faculty members to physically process their documents as well as the HR personnel to review and process said documents, will put them at a high risk of contracting the virus;*

WHEREAS, in a meeting of the Board of Regents of the University on March 17, 2021, it was approved that instead of processing new contracts, in view of the pandemic situation and the spike of new cases in Quezon City, the existing contracts of service which will end on March 15, 2021 will be extended until the end of the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of AY 2020-2021 on July 31, 2021, to ensure the safety of all personnel involved in the renewal process at the same time ensuring that the services of faculty members will not be hampered at the start of the second semester on March 22, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to ratify, as it does hereby ratify, the action of the Quezon City University Board of Regents to extend the contract period of all its Contracts of Service Faculty Members until July 31, 2021.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Quezon City Executive Department shall execute this Resolution to extend the contract period of the Contracts of Service faculty members subject to the pertinent rules relative to the renewal of contracts and upon the recommendation of the University President.
