A RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO PRIORITIZE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT OF REYNALDO A. CALALAY PUBLIC MARKET (FRISCO MARKET) LOCATED AT BARANGAY DAMAYAN, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, Section 458, par. 1 (a) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers the Sangguniang Panlungsod as:

"The Sangguniang Panlungsod, the legislative body of the city, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants x x x"

WHEREAS, Section 458, par. 5 (ii) of the same Code further provides:

“ (5) Approve ordinances which shall ensure the efficient and effective delivery of the basic services and facilities as provided for under Section 17 of this Code, and in addition to said services and facilities, shall:

(ii) Establish markets, slaughterhouses or animal corrals and authorize the operation thereof by the city government; and regulate the construction and operation of private markets, talipapas or other similar buildings and structures;”

WHEREAS, the said Public Market was formerly called Frisco Market and was later renamed to Reynaldo A. Calalay in recognition of his invaluable contribution as a public servant who served the city as Barangay Captain, City Councilor and Representative of the First District of Quezon City under approved Ordinance No. SP-1283, S-2003; 7

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to redevelop the Reynaldo A. Calalay Public Market (Frisco Market) due to the ever increasing population within the area in order to meet the demands of the consumers;

WHEREAS, the present dilapidated physical condition of the market necessitates its redevelopment for the convenience and safety of the market-goers and to ease the traffic congestion on its surroundings as a result of the new parking spaces to be allotted thereon;

WHEREAS, the redevelopment is designed as a mixed - use building with wet and dry market, basement parking, barangay hall, health center, basketball court and administration office;

WHEREAS, the redevelopment of the market could also serve as an evacuation center in case of extreme need due to natural and man-made disasters;


