RESOLUTION NO. SP- **8659**, S-2021

A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE SPECIAL PERMIT OF BIG TIME GAMING CORPORATION TO OPERATE AN ELECTRONIC GAMES (E-GAMES) ESTABLISHMENT LOCATED AT THE 2ND FLOOR, SIR THOMAS BUILDING, NO. 18 MATALINO STREET, BARANGAY CENTRAL, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR).

WHEREAS, *Big Time Gaming Corporation* is a domestic corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to operate an Electronic Games (E-Games) establishment in Quezon City, there is a need to secure a Special Permit from the City Council pursuant to Ordinance No. SP-2285, S-2014, in relation to the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, *Big Time Gaming Corporation* is earnestly requesting the City Council to grant a Special Permit to operate an E-Games establishment;

WHEREAS, the operation of E-Games is regulated and licensed by PAGCOR;

WHEREAS, the aforesaid business activity will provide employment and additional revenue to the City Government, thereby boosting the city's economy.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to renew, as it does hereby renew, the Special Permit of Big Time Gaming Corporation to operate an Electronic Games (E-games) establishment located at the 2nd Floor, Sir Thomas Building, No. 18 Matalino Street, Barangay Central, District IV, Quezon City, subject to the rules and regulations promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR).

RESOLVED FURTHER, that Big Time Gaming Corporation shall remit to the City Treasurer's Office (CTO) a franchise fee of three percent (3%) of the gross revenue of herein grantee, which shall be made payable yearly to the City Treasury during the lifetime of this measure.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that the renewed Special Permit shall be valid for a period of two (2) years and may be renewed again by the City Council.
