WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, contemplates that "every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare";

WHEREAS, the 17<sup>th</sup> Quezon City Council adopted Resolution No. SP-4511, S-2009 entitled "A Resolution urging the City Mayor, Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to initiate the establishment of a Center for the Elderly (Home for the Aged) in an appropriate location within Quezon City and allocating the necessary amount for the purpose";

WHEREAS, the 19<sup>th</sup> City Council, in its 55<sup>th</sup> Regular Session held on March 9, 2015 enacted Ordinance No. SP-2402, S-2015 entitled "An Ordinance Establishing the Quezon City Home for The Aged and Hospice Under the Supervision and Management of the Social Services Development Department;


WHEREAS, it appears that the legislative purpose did not come into fruition, hence, this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to request, as it does hereby request, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to include in the Annual Budget of the Quezon City Government for the Calendar Year 2022 or in the most convenient year, the establishment of the Quezon City "Home for the Aged and Hospice" as provided in Ordinance No. SP-2402, S-2015.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Office of the City Mayor for information and appropriate action.
