RESOLUTION NO. SP- **8683**, S-2021

A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE SPECIAL PERMIT OF WR GAMING AND ENTERTAINMENT CORPORATION TO OPERATE AN ELECTRONIC GAMES (E-GAMES) STATION AT NO. 186 TOMAS MORATO AVENUE, BARANGAY SACRED HEART, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR).

WHEREAS, WR Gaming and Entertainment Corporation, a corporation formed and registered under Philippine laws located at No. 186 Tomas Morato Avenue, Barangay Sacred Heart, District IV, Quezon City, is applying for the renewal of its Special Permit to operate an Electronic Games;

WHEREAS, sometime in 2019, the City Council passed a Resolution granting a Special Permit to the applicant to operate the said Electronic Games docketed as Resolution No. SP-7815, S-2019;

WHEREAS, to enable WR Gaming and Entertainment Corporation to continue its legal business operation, there is a need to renew the said Special Permit;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, in relation to existing City Ordinances, authorizes the City Council to grant special permit to business activity of the same nature.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to renew, as it does hereby renew, the Special Permit of WR Gaming and Entertainment Corporation to operate an Electronic Games (E-Games) Station at No. 186 Tomas Morato Avenue, Barangay Sacred Heart, District IV, Quezon City, subject to the rules and regulations promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR).


RESOLVED FURTHER, that the authority to operate an Electronic Games granted herein shall be subject to the following conditions:

- a. The holding of Electronic Games shall be in accordance with the Rules and Regulations promulgated by PAGCOR;
- b. The operation of Electronic Games shall not include the playing of games not related to or other than Electronic Games;
- c. The operator is enjoined to prohibit individuals below eighteen (18) years of age from playing in the abovementioned establishment.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that WR Gaming and Entertainment Corporation shall remit to the City Treasurer's Office a franchise fee of three percent (3%) of the gross revenue of herein grantee, which shall be made payable yearly to the City Treasury during the lifetime of this measure.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that this Special Permit to operate an Electronic Games shall be for a period of two (2) years and may be renewed by the City Council.
