A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH DMCI HOLDINGS, INC., PHILIPPINE CONTRACTORS ASSOCIATION, INC. (PCA), MEGAWIDE CONSTRUCTION CORPORATION AND MAKATI DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION (MDC) FOR THE INOCULATION OF RESIDENTS AND WORKERS IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the local government of Quezon City to extend partnership and cooperation with humanitarian organizations and private entities in addressing health issues which affect its constituents;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government is committed to collaborate with various stakeholders in its efforts to prevent, mitigate, and contain the spread of COVID-19 within its territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, to combat the COVID-19 pandemic, the Quezon City Government is inoculating the residents and workers in Quezon City with COVID-19 vaccines duly approved by the National Government;

WHEREAS, to quickly inoculate as many individuals as possible, the City Government seeks for volunteers from the private sector to add manpower to the City's vaccination sites;

WHEREAS, DMCI Holdings, Inc., Philippine Contractors Association Inc. (PCA), Megawide Construction Corporation and Makati Development Corporation (MDC), as the Vaccine Partners, will be sending medical workers and volunteers to be trained in the city's designated vaccination sites;

WHEREAS, in turn, the City Government shall inoculate with COVID-19 vaccines the qualified personnel of the member companies of the Vaccine Partners with the assistance of the medical workers and other volunteers from the Vaccine Partner's members, under the supervision of the representatives from the City Government;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

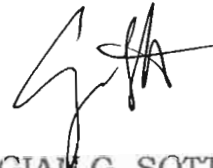

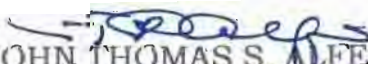
