RESOLUTION NO. SP- **8698** , S-2021

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE, ON BEHALF OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-EIGHT THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED PESOS (PHP3,448,100.00) TO FUND THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ACTIVITIES, ADVOCACY, WELFARE PROGRAM AND TRAINING COURSES OF THE QUEZON CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS' ASSOCIATION (QCPSTA) FOR THE YEAR 2021 TO BE TAKEN FROM THE CITY GENERAL FUND FISCAL YEAR 2021 OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Public School Teachers Association (QCPSTA) is a duly recognized organization of the teachers and non-teaching personnel under the supervision of the Schools Division Office of Quezon City, a duly affiliated chapter of the Philippine Public School Teachers Association and of the Alliance of Concerned Teachers (ACT), and headed by President Kristhean A. Navales, a member of Local School Board of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Public School Teachers Association (QCPSTA) has an ongoing implementation of their training, advocacy and welfare programs as stated in their "2021 Schedule of Activities and Budgetary requirements" including Medical Checkup, Annual Leadership Training Seminar, Advocacies and Sectoral Campaigns and the Publication of Newsletter;





WHEREAS, in order to achieve their mandate and defray the cost for the implementation of its activities, advocacy welfare program and training courses, there is a need to fund the said activity expenses;

WHEREAS, Section 34 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that:

"Section 34. Role of People's and Non-Governmental Organizations. - Local government units shall promote the establishment and operation of people's and non-governmental organizations to become active partners in the pursuit of local autonomy."

WHEREAS, Section 36 of the Local Government Code of 1991 also provides:


"Section 36. Assistance to People's and Non-Governmental Organizations. - A local government unit may, through its local chief executive and with the concurrence of the Sanggunian concerned, provide assistance, financial or otherwise, to such people's and non-governmental organizations for economic, socially-oriented, environmental, or cultural projects to be implemented within its territorial jurisdiction."



NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to extend financial assistance, on behalf of the Quezon City Government, in the amount of Three Million Four Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand One Hundred Pesos (Php3,448,100.00) to fund the implementation of the activities, advocacy, welfare program and training courses of the Quezon City Public School Teachers' Association (QCPSTA) for the year 2021 to be taken from the City General Fund Fiscal Year 2021 or from any available funds.
