RESOLUTION NO. SP- 8712, S-2021

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY – NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION AND TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES FOR THE REDEVELOPMENT OF THE CLOSED PAYATAS CONTROLLED DISPOSAL FACILITY INTO AN AGRO-ECO-TOURISM PARK.

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WHEREAS, the Department of Science and Technology – National Capital Region's core functions are to plan and implement programs and projects on Research and Development (R&D), technology transfer and the delivery of Science and Technology (S&T) service; and develop institutional linkages with Regional Offices, other agencies, and local government and private organizations or entities for the effective planning and implementation of S&T programs in the region;

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WHEREAS, the Technological University of the Philippines is a higher educational institution mandated to provide highly progressive leadership in applied research, developmental studies in technical, industrial and technological fields and production using indigenous materials, effect technology transfer in the countryside; and to provide expertise in the development of small and medium scale industries in identified growth centers;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government aims to provide a livable, green and sustainable city for its constituents and has the intent to redevelop the closed Payatas Controlled Disposal Facility into an Agro-Eco-Tourism Park with the purpose of providing additional income or livelihood to the residents, as well as promote urban greening and highlight its importance to life's well-being including enhancement of the existing environment for the restoration of the area;

WHEREAS, the parties herein recognize the importance of building a livable, green and sustainable city for the citizens of Quezon City, through the redevelopment of the Payatas Controlled Facility by integrating various science-based technological strategies and techniques that would provide livelihood to the people in the area as well as to promote urban greening that would alleviate social and economic development of the community;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Department of Science and Technology – National Capital Region and Technological University of the Philippines for the redevelopment of the closed Payatas Controlled Disposal Facility into an Agro-Eco-Tourism Park.

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*RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of the subject Memorandum of Understanding shall form an integral part of this Resolution.*
