WHEREAS, in furtherance of the said presidential proclamation, the Quezon City Council declared Quezon City to be under a State of Calamity on 13 March 2020;

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the local government of Quezon City to extend partnership and cooperation with humanitarian organizations and private entities in addressing health issues which affect its constituents;

WHEREAS, for purposes of improving the quality of air in the vaccination sites, Panasonic Manufacturing Philippines Corporation has generously decided to donate twenty (20) units of Panasonic nanoeTM Technology Air Purifier Model No. F-PXU70AWP with a value of Five Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty Pesos (Php599,980.00) and thirty (30) units of Panasonic Portable nanoeTM X Generator Model No. F-GPT01A-R with a value of Two Hundred Twenty-Four Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy Pesos (Php224,970.00);

WHEREAS, the civic spirit during this time of the COVID-19 pandemic of the officers and shareholders of the donor corporation is greatly appreciated by the City;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to accept the donation from Panasonic Manufacturing Philippines Corporation, represented by its Executive Director, Mr. Hiroshi Yamada, and execute the related Deed of Donation from the donor with the objective of improving the quality of air in Quezon City's vaccination sites.
