RESOLUTION NO. SP- **8730**, S-2021

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE SUPPORT AND ADHERENCE TO HOUSE BILL NO. 9971, AUTHORED AND PROPOSED BY REPRESENTATIVE ALFRED VARGAS, ENTITLED "AN ACT DIVIDING BARANGAY PASONG PUTIK IN QUEZON CITY INTO THREE (3) DISTINCT AND INDEPENDENT BARANGAYS TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY PASONG PUTIK PROPER, BARANGAY GREATER LAGRO AND BARANGAY NORTH FAIRVIEW."

Introduced by Councilor PATRICK MICHAEL VARGAS.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that the barangay is the basic political unit which serves as the primary planning and implementing unit of government policies, plans, programs, projects, and activities in the community, and as a forum wherein the collective views of the people may be expressed, crystallized and considered, and where disputes may be amicably settled;

WHEREAS, the basic political unit is the vanguard of providing a wide array of frontline basic services to the citizens and to the community; its fiscal autonomy shall be critical in strengthening the capabilities of each barangay to perform its duties and responsibilities to the Filipino people;

WHEREAS, the power to create a certain barangay is provided for under the Local Government Code of 1991; however, a Congressional enactment formally provides for its direct share from the Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) provided for in the annual General Appropriations Act;

WHEREAS, the barangays of Pasong Putik Proper, Greater Lagro, and North Fairview have been created from the division of then-Barangay Pasong Putik by the City Council of Quezon City through Ordinance No. SP-439, S-1996, and was ratified and approved by a majority of votes cast in the plebiscite held on December 8, 1996;

WHEREAS, for 25 years, Barangay Pasong Putik Proper, Barangay Greater Lagro, and Barangay North Fairview have been recognized by the Local Government of Quezon City as official barangays having been created pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991 and are included in Republic Act No. 10170, entitled “An Act Reapportioning the Second Legislative District of Quezon City, Creating Two (2) Additional Legislative Districts”, as three of the fourteen barangays of the Fifth District of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, Section 6, Article X of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that Local Government Units (LGUs) shall have a just share as determined by law in the national taxes which shall be automatically released to them;

WHEREAS, since its inception however, these barangays have yet to receive its rightful share of the Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) due to the lack of a formal Congressional enactment providing for its direct share from the IRA as included in the annual General Appropriations Act;

WHEREAS, on 13 September 2021, the House of Representatives has approved on third and final reading House Bill No. 9971, authored by Quezon City Fifth District Representative Alfred Vargas, entitled “An Act Dividing Barangay Pasong Putik in Quezon City into Three (3) Distinct and Independent Barangays to be known as Barangay Pasong Putik Proper, Barangay Greater Lagro and Barangay North Fairview.”

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to express, as it does hereby express, the support and adherence to House Bill No. 9971, authored and proposed by Representative Alfred Vargas, entitled “An Act Dividing Barangay Pasong Putik in Quezon City into Three (3) Distinct and Independent Barangays to be known as Barangay Pasong Putik Proper, Barangay Greater Lagro and Barangay North Fairview.”
