A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A CERTIFICATE OF EXCEPTION TO IGLESIA NI CRISTO (AS TO LAND USE, FAR, PARKING AND DENSITY) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF TWO (2) TWENTY (20)-STOREY MINISTER'S CONDOMINIUM BUILDING WITH TWO (2) BASEMENT PARKING LEVEL (BUILDINGS 1 AND 2) LOCATED AT LOTS 684-G-1-B-2, 683-B-2-B, 683-B-3-A AND 683-B-3-C, NO. I MORNING STAR DRIVE, BARANGAY CULIAT, DISTRICT VI, QUEZON CITY, ALLOWING DEVIATION FROM THE RESTRICTIONS PROVIDED UNDER ORDINANCE NO. SP-2502, S-2016, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE OF 2016.

WHEREAS, the Iglesia Ni Cristo is applying for a Certificate of Exception (as to land use, far, parking and density) for the construction and operation of Two (2) Twenty (20)-Storey Minister's Condominium Building with Two (2) Basement Parking Level (Buildings 1 and 2) located at Lots 684-G-1-B-2, 683-B-2-B, 683-B-3-A and 683-B-3-C, No. 1 Morning Star Drive, Barangay Culiat, District VI, Quezon City,

WHEREAS, the location of the proposed project is classified as Medium Density Residential Zone (C-2) where the said project is not permissible with respect to land use, far, parking and density, thus, the issuance of a Certificate of Exception is being requested by the Iglesia Ni Cristo before the City Council to be exempt from zoning restrictions;

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Section 55, Article VIII, in relation to Sections 71 and 73, Article IX of Ordinance No. SP-2502, S-2016, an exception or deviations from the provisions of Zoning Ordinance may be allowed only upon authorization from the City Council;

WHEREAS, the proposed project will not adversely affect public health, safety, and welfare and is in keeping with the general pattern of development in the community;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay and the homeowners concerned have interposed no objection to the said project;

WHEREAS, the applicant has complied with the necessary requirements prescribed by law, ordinance or administrative issuances.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the issuance of a Certificate of Exception to Iglesia Ni Cristo (as to land use, far, parking and density) for the construction and operation of Two (2) Twenty (20)-Storey Minister's Condominium Building with Two (2) Basement Parking Level (Buildings 1 and 2) located at Lots 684-G-1-B-2, 683-B-2-B, 683-B-3-A and 683-B-3-C, No. 1 Morning Star Drive, Barangay Culiat, District VI, Quezon City, allowing deviation from the restrictions provided under Ordinance No. SP-2502, S-2016, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 2016.
