RESOLUTION NO. SP- **8736**, S-2021

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE NATIONAL HOUSING AUTHORITY (NHA), REPRESENTED BY ITS GENERAL MANAGER, MARCELINO P. ESCALADA, JR., AND THE MUNICIPALITY OF NORZAGARAY, BULACAN, REPRESENTED BY ITS MAYOR, HONORABLE ALFREDO "FRED" GERMAR, FOR THE PROVISION OF ASSISTANCE FOR PROGRAMS, PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF NORZAGARAY, BULACAN, FOR THE BENEFIT OF RELOCATED INFORMAL SETTLER FAMILIES (ISFs) FROM QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, it is the declared policy of the state to provide the people with adequate and decent housing facilities and to encourage various stakeholders to participate in the program of the government;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 90 dated December 17, 1986 mandated the National Housing Authority (NHA) as the sole production agency to meet the housing needs of the low income and marginal families in the urban and urbanizing areas;

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WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, and Republic Act No. 7279, otherwise known as the Urban Development and Housing Act of 1992, Local Government Units are mandated to take a principal role in the provision of housing services to its constituents;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government will be relocating its informal settler families (ISFs) to the resettlement site of the National Housing Authority situated in the Municipality of Norzagaray, Bulacan;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Norzagaray, Bulacan has agreed to receive the ISFs-relocatees from Quezon City to be placed in the NHA Resettlement Site situated within its territorial jurisdiction, however, due to its limited resources and budgetary constraints to provide and sustain the essential needs of the relocatees, there is a need for a support from the sending LGU;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government is well aware that to live a humane life at the relocation site, the resettled ISFs need to have an access to basic needs such as education, health, permanent utility services, affordable transportation, peace and order and livelihood programs;

WHEREAS, pending the availability and provision of post relocation assistances and services mandated under the resettlement program of the national government, the Quezon City Government agrees to provide support services in the areas of education, health, permanent utility services, affordable transportation, peace and order and livelihood programs to the Municipal Government of Norzagaray, Bulacan;

WHEREAS, the National Housing Authority has allocated and certified the availability of the units for the relocation of informal settler families (ISFs) coming from Quezon City;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 61 (a) of the Local Government Code of 1991, provinces, cities and municipalities may, upon approval of a majority of all members of the Sanggunian concerned and in amounts not exceeding their surplus funds, extend loans, grants or subsidies to other Local Government Units under such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon by the contracting parties;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government shall provide assistance for programs, projects and activities to the Municipality of Norzagaray, Bulacan within five (5) years (2020-2025) and both parties will mutually agree on the mode of the assistance that would address such needs;

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WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the National Housing Authority (NHA), represented by its General Manager, Marcelino P. Escalada, Jr., and the Municipality of Norzagaray, Bulacan, represented by its Mayor, Honorable Alfredo "Fred" Germar, for the provision of assistance for programs, projects and activities to the Municipality of Norzagaray, Bulacan, for the benefit of relocated informal settler families (ISFs) from Quezon City.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of the subject Memorandum of Agreement shall form an integral part of this Resolution.
