A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO K & I PETRON SERVICE CENTER FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF A PETRON GASOLINE REFILLING STATION AND LUBE SERVICE CENTER (AS BUILT) LOCATED AT NO. 66 QUEZON AVENUE CORNER BMA AVENUE, BARANGAY TATALON, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, K & I Petron Service Center is applying for a Special Use Permit for the construction and operation of a Petron Gasoline Refilling Station and Lube Service Center (As Built) located at No. 66 Quezon Avenue corner BMA Avenue, Barangay Tatalon, District IV, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. SP-2502, S-2016, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 2016, a Special Use Permit is required prior to the operation of a gasoline station;

WHEREAS, the Special Use Permit shall be subject to the following conditions, to wit: (a) the exception will not adversely affect the public health, safety and welfare, and is in keeping with the general pattern of development in the community; (b) the proposed project shall support economic-based activities and provide livelihood, vital community services and facilities and at the same time, pose no adverse effect on the zone or community; (c) the exception will not adversely affect the appropriate use of the adjoining property in the same district; and (d) the exception will not alter the essential character and general purpose of the district where the exception sought is located;

WHEREAS, the applicant has complied with all the documentary and mandatory requirements as provided under existing and applicable laws, rules, ordinances and issuances.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the issuance of a Special Use Permit to K & I Petron Service Center for the construction and operation of a Petron Gasoline Refilling Station and Lube Service Center (as built) located at No. 66 Quezon Avenue corner BMA Avenue, Barangay Tatalon, District IV, Quezon City.


