A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (PHP500,000.00) IN FAVOR OF THE PHILIPPINE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY-QUEZON CITY (PCCI-QC), SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE 3RD QUEZON CITY BUSINESS CONFERENCE (QCBC).


