A RESOLUTION URGING ALL BIKE SHOPS AND ACTIVE TRANSPORT SHOPS TO PROMOTE SAFE CYCLING BY POSTING ALL RELEVANT INFORMATION ON SAFE CYCLING AND ACTIVE TRANSPORT IN A CONSPICUOUS AREA IN THEIR RESPECTIVE PLACES OF BUSINESSES.

WHEREAS, Sections 15 and 16, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution, provides that it is the policy of the State to protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them. It is also the duty of the State to protect the environment for a balanced and healthful ecology;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government, through the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte signed Ordinance No. SP-2988, S-2020, entitled "QC Safe Cycling and Active Transport Ordinance of 2020" which encourages all the residents to use bicycles and active transport as alternative modes of transportation;

WHEREAS, the use of bicycle and active transport promotes health and serves as an alternative solution to high prices of fuel, increasing fares, traffic, noise and air pollution, and the high cost of vehicles;

WHEREAS, it has been recognized that during the pandemic, there has been a drastic increase in the number of bicycle and active transport users within the jurisdiction of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, unlike the traditional modes of transportation, there are established formal means for cyclists and active transport users to gain knowledge on road safety protocols and develop skills on proper cycling and active transport use;

WHEREAS, to ensure the safety of cyclists and active transport users, there is a need to broaden the possible sources of information and education materials on the practice of safe cycling and active transport use from the merchants and distributors operating within the jurisdiction of Quezon City.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, all bike shops and active transport shops to promote safe cycling by posting all relevant information on safe cycling and active transport in a conspicuous area in their respective places of businesses.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to ensure that a $1M \times 1M$ information board be installed in a conspicuous area in their respective places of business.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that a copy of this Resolution be furnished to all bike and active transport shops for their appropriate implementation.
