RESOLUTION NO. SP- 8817, S-2021

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO PURCHASE TWO (2) UNITS OF MOTOR VEHICLE TO BE USED BY THE OFFICE OF COUNCILOR IRENE R. BELMONTE, 4TH DISTRICT OF QUEZON CITY, FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION AND MONITORING OF VARIOUS PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE MILLION EIGHTY THOUSAND PESOS (PHP3,080,000.00) TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE GENERAL FUND OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR, SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, the Office of Councilor Irene R. Belmonte is requesting for the purchase of two (2) units of motor vehicle intended for the implementation and monitoring of various projects and programs;

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WHEREAS, pursuant to the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) Memorandum Circular No. 2015-02, amending certain provisions of the Guidelines on Motor Vehicle Acquisition by the Local Government Units, particularly Item 2.1 Motor Vehicle purchases may be sourced from the following:

“2.1.1 Unencumbered local funds, as referred to under Presidential Administrative Order No. 223, are local funds free from obligation not yet obligated, but are intended for the purpose for which it was appropriated. It may include unobligated loan proceeds in the local treasury, which were taken up in the books of the LGU as trust fund, for the fulfillment of an obligation or purpose in which the loan was contracted and approved.”

WHEREAS, in a Certification of the Availability of Fund dated August 17, 2021 signed by the City Budget Officer stated that there is an available appropriation intended for the acquisition of two (2) units of motor vehicle as service vehicle to be used by the Office of Councilor Irene R. Belmonte for the implementation and monitoring of various projects and programs;

WHEREAS, in Approved Advice of Allotment No. 21-01083 the said two (2) units of motor vehicle was allotted based under Ordinance Nos. SP-2977, S-2020 and SP-3030, S-2021;

WHEREAS, the specification of the motor vehicle to be procured are the following:

WHEREAS, Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Administrative Order No. 15, S-2011, amending Administrative Order No. 233, S-2008, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, has already sought permission and authorization from the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) for the acquisition of the above-described motorized vehicles which is included in the FY 2021 Annual General Fund. Said permission is hereto attached and made an integral part of this Resolution.


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NOW, THEREFORE,

Belmonte, to purchase two (2) units of motor vehicle to be used by the Office of Councilor Irene R. Belmonte, 4th District of Quezon City, for the implementation and monitoring of various projects and programs in the amount of Three Million Eighty Thousand Pesos (Php3,080,000.00) to be charged against the General Fund of the Office of the City Mayor, subject to existing laws and regulations.


