RESOLUTION NO. SP-8861, S-2022

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AMOUNTING TO THREE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-SEVEN PESOS (PHP3,765,797.00) TO THE BOY SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES - QUEZON CITY COUNCIL TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST OF ITS OPERATIONAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES AND OTHER RELEVANT ACTIVITIES FOR THE YEAR 2022.

WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines - Quezon City Council is a government recognized organization duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, for the purpose of promoting, supervising and administering the programs of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines for character development and citizenship training, among many others, within the territorial jurisdiction of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, in the desire to further enhance the scouting movement in Quezon City and to be able to accomplish the aims and purposes for which the organization was established, such as to inculcate responsibility, discipline and moral values, the Quezon City Government has approved several programs and activities in line with the objectives of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines - Quezon City Council has no sufficient funds or financial capability to cover the budget needed to implement successfully the said plans and programs, as well as the scheduled virtual activities;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government, as manifested in previous years, is willing to extend financial support in order to carry out such plans and programs by way of allocating an appropriate amount from the budget of the City Mayor under the General Funds for Youth Development Training Program;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government also commits to extend annual fund assistance to the Boy Scouts of the Philippines - Quezon City Council to help defray the cost in the implementation of the activities and training courses, designed to help prepare the youth of Quezon City to become responsible leaders, develop them into a morally straight, disciplined and concerned citizens of the country, to be charged against the budget of the Office of the City Mayor under the General Funds for Youth Development Training Program in the amount of Three Million Seven Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety-Seven Pesos (Php3, 765, 797.00);

WHEREAS, to extend the aforesaid financial assistance, there is a need for the City Council to authorize the Honorable City Mayor to allocate and release the necessary funds for the same, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules.
