RESOLUTION NO. SP-**8865**, S-2022

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A CERTIFICATE OF EXCEPTION TO INTEGRATED CONTRACTOR AND PLUMBING WORK, INC. FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A TWO (2)-STOREY COMMERCIAL BUILDING WITH COVERED MULTI-PURPOSE AREA AND ROOF DECK (AS BUILT) LOCATED AT LOT 8, BLOCK 17, NO. 17 PARAISO STREET, BARANGAY PARAISO, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY, ALLOWING DEVIATION FROM THE RESTRICTIONS PROVIDED UNDER ORDINANCE NO. SP-2502, S-2016, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE OF 2016.

WHEREAS, the *Integrated Contractor and Plumbing Work, Inc.* is applying for the issuance of a Certificate of Exception for the construction of a Two (2)-Storey Commercial Building with covered Multi-Purpose Area and Roof Deck (As Built) located at Lot 8, Block 17, No. 17 Paraiso Street, Barangay Paraiso, District I, Quezon City, in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. SP-2502, S-2016, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 2016;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the aforesaid zoning ordinance, the construction of the proposed project may be allowed only upon authorization by the Quezon City Council;

WHEREAS, the proposed project will not adversely affect public health, safety and welfare, and is in keeping with the general pattern of development in the community;

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WHEREAS, the purpose of the application is to comply with the parking requirements and zone classification prescribed by the zoning ordinance;


WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay concerned, as well as the homeowners or residents thereat, did not interpose any objection to the proposed project;

WHEREAS, the applicant has submitted all the necessary and mandatory requirements in support of the proposed project and undertakes to comply with the provisions of existing laws, ordinances, and rules and regulations pertaining to public safety, environmental protection, and vehicular traffic.


NOW, THEREFORE,


