A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE QUEZON CITY GENERAL HOSPITAL (QCGH) TO MANAGE ITS OWN DIALYSIS UNIT.

WHEREAS, Section 65 (d) of Republic Act No. 6548, states that one of the duties of the Director of Hospital is "to recommend to the City Council such measures or ordinances, including the annual budget of the hospital in the form and with contents prescribed by the City Council, as may be deemed necessary for the operation and maintenance of the hospital and for providing medical care and to execute and enforce all laws, ordinances, rules and regulations pertaining to patients care and hospital matters";

WHEREAS, in compliance with the requirements set by the Department of Health (DOH) through an Administrative Order No. 2012-0012-A, the QCGH being a Level 3 Hospital is obliged to have its own Licensed Dialysis Facility;

WHEREAS, previous resolutions issued by the City Council regarding the QCGH Dialysis Unit had been approved and operated by private companies under a Lease Agreement;

WHEREAS, the said lease agreements needed to be renewed annually which proved to be cumbersome and hampers the continuity of dialysis services to the patients;


WHEREAS, QCGH has the capacity to manage its own Dialysis Unit since it now possesses ten (10) dialysis machines from the Quezon City Health Department Super Health Centers and was able to hire and employ its own dialysis nurses. At present, QCGH only needs to hire other medical staff like Physician(s)-on-Duty, Administrator/Unit Manager and dedicated Renal Technician(s);

WHEREAS, there is an available approved annual budget for the supplies and maintenance of a dialysis unit and a Supply and Maintenance Agreement shall be engaged by the hospital through a bidding process.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to allow, as it does hereby allow, the Quezon City General Hospital (QCGH) to manage its own Dialysis Unit, to hire the needed and required medical staff and to maintain the dialysis machines through bidding process.


