A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE UNITED SENIOR CITIZENS ASSOCIATION OF ALL DISTRICTS OF QUEZON CITY, INC. AS THE COLLEGIAL AND CONFEDERATED BODY OF ALL BARANGAY SENIOR CITIZENS ASSOCIATIONS, ORGANIZATIONS, AND CHAPTERS REGISTERED WITH THE QUEZON CITY-OFFICE FOR THE SENIOR CITIZENS AFFAIRS (QC-OSCA), EXCEPT THE FEDERATION OF SENIOR CITIZENS ASSOCIATION OF THE PHILIPPINES, INC. (FSCAP) AND ITS CHAPTERS AND ORGANIZATIONS.

*WHEREAS, under Republic Act No. 9994, otherwise known as the "Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2010", the City Government is mandated to adopt measures whereby senior citizens are recognized to take their proper place in the society and given full support towards the improvement of their total-well-being so as to encourage them to contribute in nation building;*


*WHEREAS, pursuant to the said Republic Act, the local government units are likewise mandated to provide mechanisms whereby senior citizens are properly assisted, appreciated by the community as a whole and that their contributions are maximized;*

*WHEREAS, the 20<sup>th</sup> City Council passed Ordinance No. SP-2577, S-2017, entitled "an ordinance establishing a system of registration in all barangays of Quezon City to enlist any senior citizen group, organization, association, and/or chapters established and operating within their respective territorial jurisdiction upon the latter's compliance with the necessary registration requirements";*

*WHEREAS, the United Senior Citizens Association of All Districts of Quezon City, Inc., a non-government association duly registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) and operating under existing laws, was formed and organized by the duly elected Senior Citizens Barangay Federation Presidents from the Six (6) Districts of Quezon City in their aim to consolidate all the barangay-based senior citizens organizations and associations in Quezon City, except the Federation of Senior Citizens Associations of the Philippines (FSCAP), its chapters and organizations, and to officially represent them in all their dealings and transactions with the Quezon City Government and the National Government;*

*WHEREAS, the United Senior Citizens Association of All Districts of Quezon City, Inc. is duly recognized by the Quezon City-Office for the Senior Citizens Affairs (QC-OSCA) as the collegial body of all barangay-based senior citizens associations, organizations, and chapters which it likewise recognized. In fact, the QC-OSCA has allocated a space within its office for the use of the said organization as its physical center for its operations and administration;*

*WHEREAS, in order to harmonize the programs and projects of the City Government for the benefit and welfare of the resident senior citizens of Quezon City, it is imperative that the United Senior Citizens Association of All Districts of Quezon City, Inc. be officially recognized by the Quezon City Government for it to be able to officially represent all barangay-based senior citizens organizations, associations, and chapters, exempting the Federation of Senior Citizens Association of the Philippines, Inc. and its chapters, in the local and national government dealings, as well as for easier recognition of these bodies and faster delivery of services among all their senior citizen members residing in Quezon City.*







NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to recognize, as it does hereby recognize, the United Senior Citizens Association of All Districts of Quezon City, Inc. as the collegial and confederated body of all barangay senior citizens associations, organizations, and chapters registered with the Quezon City-Office for the Senior Citizens Affairs (QC-OSCA), except the Federation of Senior Citizens Association of the Philippines, Inc. (FSCAP) and its chapters and organizations.
