WHEREAS, the QCPBFI aims to uplift the general welfare and benefits of all the former Punong Barangays who had served in the different barangays of Quezon City. It likewise aims to develop networking strategies and mechanism for cooperation and sharing in barangay best practices for good governance and delivery of services to various fields, such as, but not limited to peace and order, health care, education, environmental protection, livelihood, housing, and disaster risk reduction, mitigation, emergency response and restoration in all the barangays in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the organization needs financial support for an easier and more efficient realization and pursuance of the above-stated purposes;

WHEREAS, as provided in its Amended Articles of Incorporation, the QCPBFI may solicit, accept and receive donations, money, grants, gifts, contributions and financial assistance from any person, institution, organization, or entity;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government recognizes the contributions of all its former Punong Barangays in nation building, as well as to the society development that the City has attained. Thus, it is indeed necessary to support the strengthening of the former Punong Barangays' general welfare and benefits by extending financial assistance to QCPBFI;

WHEREAS, the 21st Quezon City Council approved Resolution No. SP-8556, S-2021, which provided financial assistance to QCPBFI for the year 2021;

WHEREAS, the QCPBFI has been continuously conducting its programs and supporting its former Punong Barangay members until the present, especially in this dire time of pandemic.
