BELMONTE, TO DONATE VARIOUS EQUIPMENT, FURNITURE AND FIXTURES TO SELECTED NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS IN QUEZON CITY, AND TO TRANSFER THE OWNERSHIP OF SAID VARIOUS EQUIPMENT, FURNITURE AND FIXTURES TO RECIPIENTS WITHOUT COST.

WHEREAS, it is the declared policy of the Quezon City Government to provide the necessary infrastructure/equipment to our barangays, non-stock and non-profit organizations to ensure proper and efficient delivery of services to its constituents;

WHEREAS, in pursuit of the aforesaid policy, the Quezon City government, represented herein by the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, through the initiative of the Office of Councilor Hero M. Bautista, has procured various equipment such as Photo Copying and Duplicating Machine, Cabinet and Open Shelves, Cabinet Drawers Mobile Pedestal, Clerical Tables and Chairs, Computer Table with Printer Stand, Sets of Computer and Printers, Computer Laptop, Inverter Air-conditioner, Roller Blinds, Projector, Camera, and Industrial Fan for the use of different non-governmental organizations (NGO's) like Barangay K.U.L.I.T.A.N. QC, Inc., United Coordinators of Quezon City, Inc., Harapin ang Bukas sa Quezon City, Inc., Batang QC Foundation, Inc., Alay kay Inay ng Lungsod Quezon Foundation, Inc. among others;




WHEREAS, the said equipment, furniture and fixtures will facilitate delivery of public and social services to the concerned sectors and stakeholders;

WHEREAS, as the primary source of funding for the said equipment, furniture and fixtures, it is incumbent upon the City Government to undertake proper turn-over to the intended recipients in order to conform to the government auditing requirements;

WHEREAS, a Deed of Donation shall be executed with the recipients transferring the ownership of the said various equipment, furniture and fixtures through donation.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the Quezon City Government, through the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to donate various equipment, furniture and fixtures to selected non-governmental organizations in Quezon City, and to transfer the ownership of said various equipment, furniture and fixtures to recipients without cost.


