A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. SP-8716, S-2021, ENTITLED "A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO SAUYO TRANSPORT CORPORATION FOR THE OPERATION OF A TERMINAL (AS BUILT) LOCATED AT LOT 103-B-1, QUIRINO HIGHWAY, BARANGAY NOVALICHES PROPER, DISTRICT V, QUEZON CITY, ALLOWING DEVIATION FROM THE RESTRICTIONS PROVIDED UNDER ORDINANCE NO. SP-2502, S-2016, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE OF 2016", BY REPLACING IN THE WHEREAS CLAUSE THE WORD "BUS" TO "UV EXPRESS VANS."
