RESOLUTION NO. SP-8985, S-2022

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO VICTORY LINER, INC. FOR THE OPERATION OF A BUS TERMINAL (AS BUILT) LOCATED AT NO. 766 EDSA CORNER MAPAGMAHAL STREET, BARANGAY PINYAHAN, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY.

Introduced by Councilor IVY L. LAGMAN.

WHEREAS, Victory Liner Inc., a duly registered business entity under Philippine Laws, is applying for the issuance of a Special Use Permit (SUP) for the operation of a Bus Terminal (As Built) located at No. 766 EDSA corner Mapagmahal Street, Barangay Pinyahan, District IV, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. SP-2502, S-2016, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 2016, an exception is required for the aforementioned project upon authorization by the Quezon City Council;

WHEREAS, the operation of a Bus Terminal in the area will not adversely affect the public welfare, but instead generate employment opportunity and promote the development of the city's economy;

WHEREAS, Victory Liner Inc. has complied with all the requirements for their application and that the members of the Sangguniang Barangay did not interpose any objection to the operation of the said business establishment.

NOW, THEREFORE,



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the issuance of a Special Use Permit to Victory Liner, Inc. for the operation of a Bus Terminal (As Built) located at No. 766 EDSA corner Mapagmahal Street, Barangay Pinyahan, District IV, Quezon City.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Special Use Permit (SUP) shall be annulled by operation of law in case the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) revokes its franchise and upon violation of applicable special laws, rules and regulations.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that this measure granting Special Use Permit (SUP) shall be effective for a period of three (3) years commencing from the date of adoption.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that only buses of the company with appropriate body markings shall use the terminal.
