A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, THROUGH THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO PURCHASE ONE (1) UNIT OF MOTOR VEHICLE INTENDED FOR THE MONITORING AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS OF THE GENDER AND DEVELOPMENT (GAD) COUNCIL, GAD TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP AND GAD SECRETARIAT, TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, on 16 May 2016, the 19th City Council of Quezon City approved Ordinance No. SP-1402, S-2016, entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance Providing for a City Gender and Development Code, and to Harmonize with the Provisions of Republic Act No. 9710, otherwise known as "The Magna Carta for Women", and to Adopt the UN Women's Safe cities and safe public spaces initiative";

WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-1402, S-2016 provides for the creation of the Gender and Development Council, GAD Technical Working Group and the GAD Secretariat, to ensure the effective and efficient implementation of the GAD programs and activities;
