A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE (DA) FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ENHANCED KADIWA INCLUSIVE FOOD SUPPLY CHAIN PROGRAM IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture is mandated to promote agricultural development by providing policy framework, public investments, and support services needed for domestic and export-oriented business enterprises;

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture has launched the Enhanced Kadiwa Inclusive Food Supply Chain Program to ensure food accessibility during the pandemic and beyond;

WHEREAS, under the program, the Department of Agriculture provides financial assistance to participating eligible organizations and Local Government Units (LGUs) to enhance their capacities in value-adding activities in the food supply chain from aggregation, processing, packing, storing, warehousing, transport to distribution;

WHEREAS, the parties recognize the need for a provision of Financial Grant Assistance to Local Government Units (LGUs), Farmers and Fisherfolk Cooperatives/Associations (FCAs) and Community-Based Organizations under the “Enhanced Kadiwa ni Ani at Kita Inclusive Food Supply Chain Program”, as per approved Department of Agriculture Memorandum Circular No. 16, S.2020 and its amendments, which is essential for the continuous supply of food in major cities and demand centers;


WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Department of Agriculture (DA) for the implementation of the Enhanced Kadiwa Inclusive Food Supply Chain Program in Quezon City.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of the subject Memorandum of Agreement shall form an integral part of this Resolution.
