A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, THROUGH THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO PURCHASE ONE (1) UNIT OF MOTOR VEHICLE PASSENGER VAN INTENDED FOR THE MONITORING AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC ORDER AND SAFETY (DPOS), TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE APPROVED FUNDS OF THE PUBLIC ORDER AND SAFETY PLAN OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance;

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WHEREAS, the Department of Public Order and Safety (DPOS) is the arm of the city in promoting public order, security, and peace in the city. It is mandated to maintain orderliness through the strict implementation of all existing rules governing land use, as well as other rules related to the maintenance of peace and order;

WHEREAS, the DPOS is requesting for the purchase of one (1) unit of motor vehicle with the following specifications:
