A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE PHILIPPINE SPORTS COMMISSION FOR THE CASH INCENTIVES TO BE GRANTED TO QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT WHICH WON 3<sup>RD</sup> PLACE IN THE OVERALL OFFICIAL MEDAL TALLY IN THE BATANG PINOY 2022 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS HELD IN THE CITY OF VIGAN, PROVINCE OF ILOCOS SUR.

*WHEREAS, the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC), by virtue of Republic Act No. 6847, encourages wide participation of all sectors, government and private, in amateur sports promotion and development, and provides incentives, recognitions and awards to deserving associations, athletes, referees, game officials, coaches, trainers and other persons or entities involved in or supporting sports development as may be permissible under the rules of amateurism;*

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 44, Series of 1998 created the Philippine Youth Games - Batang Pinoy (Batang Pinoy) as an integral part of the national policy and program for sports development which will effectively address the country's need for a comprehensive grassroots sports program centered on values formation, inherent in the practice of sports and play, such as patriotism, nationalism, self-discipline, respect for law and order, hard work, teamwork, camaraderie, sportsmanship, and fair play, thus eliminating the child's chances of becoming a juvenile delinquent;

WHEREAS, the PSC, in partnership with the Provincial Government of Ilocos Sur, hosted and organized the Batang Pinoy 2022 National Championships held in the City of Vigan, Province of Ilocos Sur from December 17-21, 2022;

WHEREAS, the PSC grants incentives to the top 5 Local Government Units (LGU) in the Batang Pinoy 2022 National Championships based on the overall official medal tally to be used for the LGU's grassroots sports promotion and development and talent identification programs;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government participated in the Batang Pinoy 2022 National Championships and won 3<sup>rd</sup> Place in the overall official medal tally;

WHEREAS, the PSC, through Resolution No. 002-2023 dated January 10, 2023, approved the signing of this Memorandum of Agreement and authorized the Chairman to enter into this Agreement on behalf of PSC;

WHEREAS, there is a need for the City to grant authority to the City Mayor before signing the Memorandum of Agreement for, and in behalf of, the Quezon City Government;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455(b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.
