WHEREAS, *Big Time Gaming Corporation* is engaged in the business of *Electronic Bingo and Traditional Bingo*;

WHEREAS, the applicant was previously granted a *Special Permit* by the *Quezon City Council* for the operation of the same business, through *Resolution No. SP-7892, S-2019*;

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to operate *Electronic Bingo and Traditional Bingo* in *Quezon City*, there is a need to secure a *Special Permit* from the *City Council* pursuant to *Ordinance No. SP-2285, S-2014*, in relation to the provisions of *Republic Act No. 7160*, otherwise known as the *Local Government Code of 1991*;

WHEREAS, the operation of *Electronic Bingo and Traditional Bingo* is regulated and licensed by the *Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR)*;

WHEREAS, *Big Time Gaming Corporation* is requesting the *City Council* to grant a *Special Permit* to operate *Electronic Bingo and Traditional Bingo*.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to renew, as it does hereby renew, the *Special Permit* of *Big Time Gaming Corporation* to operate *Electronic Bingo and Traditional Bingo* at the *Ground Floor, Icon Hotel, No. 967 Epifanio Delos Santos Avenue corner West Avenue, Barangay Philam, District I, Quezon City*, subject to the rules and regulations promulgated by the *Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR)*.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that *Big Time Gaming Corporation* shall remit to the *City Treasurer's Office* a franchise fee of three percent (3%) of the gross revenue of herein grantee, which shall be made payable yearly to the *City Treasurer's Office* during the lifetime of this Resolution.

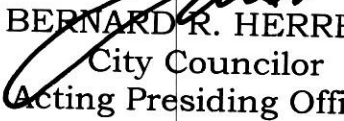


