CAYABYAB, FOR THE OPERATION OF A PROPOSED ONE (1)-STOREY BUS TERMINAL (DLTB AURORA) LOCATED AT LOT 15 PSD-10508, (NO. 823) AURORA BOULEVARD, BARANGAY IMMACULATE CONCEPCION, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY

WHEREAS, Del Monte Land Transport Bus Company Inc., as represented by Rozladino C. Cayabyab, is applying for the issuance of a Special Use Permit for the operation of a Proposed One (1)-Storey Bus Terminal (DLTB Aurora) located at Lot 15 PSD-10508, (No. 823) Aurora Boulevard, Barangay Immaculate Concepcion, District IV, Quezon City;

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WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 55(2), Article VIII of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2502, S-2016, a Special Use Permit is required for the aforesaid Project upon authorization from the City Council;

WHEREAS, Del Monte Land Transport Bus Company Inc. has complied with all the necessary requirements prescribed by laws, ordinances and administrative issuances in its application for a Special Use Permit for its Bus Line with parking and terminal;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Immaculate Concepcion and the neighbors concerned have interposed no objection to the said Project;

WHEREAS, the applicant, Del Monte Land Transport Bus Company Inc., has submitted all the necessary and mandatory requirements in support of the application for a Special Use Permit, and undertakes to comply with the provisions of existing laws, ordinances, and rules and regulations pertaining to public safety, environmental protection, and vehicular traffic;

WHEREAS, the Special Use Permit shall be annulled by operation of law in case the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) revokes the franchise of the said Transport Company;

WHEREAS, only buses of the Company with appropriate body markings shall use the subject Terminal.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the issuance of a Special Use Permit to Del Monte Land Transport Bus Company Inc., as represented by Rozladino C. Cayabyab, for the operation of a Proposed One (1)-Storey Bus Terminal (DLTB Aurora) located at Lot 15 PSD-10508, (No. 823) Aurora Boulevard, Barangay Immaculate Concepcion, District IV, Quezon City.
