A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE DEVELOPMENT ACADEMY OF THE PHILIPPINES, WITH A CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE MILLION ONE HUNDRED EIGHTEEN THOUSAND EIGHTY PESOS (PHP3,118,080.00), FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROJECT ENTITLED "PHASE 2: EXPANSION AND SUSTENANCE OF THE ISO 9001:2015 CERTIFIED QUALITY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT (QCG)"

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government recognizes the role of a Quality Management System (QMS) in enhancing service delivery and operational efficiency, as mandated by various standards and frameworks that guide public administration;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government aims to expand its ISO 9001:2015 Certified QMS to other City offices or departments, thereby improving productivity and service quality across its operations, in alignment with the objectives set forth in the Philippine Development Plan (PDP) 2023-2028;

WHEREAS, the Development Academy of the Philippines (DAP) serves as the National Productivity Organization, tasked under Executive Order No. 605, S. 2007 issued by the Office of the President, to promote and enhance productivity and quality management practices across various sectors of the economy;

WHEREAS, the necessary procurement process has been completed, resulting in BAC Resolution No. 24-030, S-2024, which endorses the services of DAP for this initiative, as per the provisions of Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9485, otherwise known as the Anti-Red Tape Act of 2007, mandates government agencies to streamline their processes and enhance service delivery, which can be effectively supported by an ISO-certified QMS;

WHEREAS, Section 455(b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, grants the City Mayor the authority to represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into an Agreement with the Development Academy of the Philippines, with a contract in the amount of Three Million One Hundred Eighteen Thousand Eighty Pesos (Php3,118,080.00), for the implementation of the project entitled "Phase 2: Expansion and Sustenance of the ISO 9001:2015 Certified Quality Management System of the Quezon City Government (QCG)."




