RESOLUTION NO. SP- 9994, S-2025

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE MILLION PESOS (PHP3,000,000.00) TO THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF SADANGA, MOUNTAIN PROVINCE DUE TO THE ADVERSE IMPACTS OF TYPHOON EGAY (INTERNATIONAL NAME: DOKSURI)

WHEREAS, on July 24, 2023, at 1600 UTC+7, Typhoon Egay (International Name: Doksuri), steadily intensified as it moved north-northwestward. According to the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA), the center of Typhoon Doksuri was estimated, based on all available data including Daet Doppler Weather Radar, to be around 500 kilometers East of Baler, Aurora, Philippines;

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WHEREAS, Typhoon Egay moved north northwestward at 10 km/h with maximum sustained winds of 155 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 190 km/h, central pressure of 955 hPa, and strong to typhoon-force winds extended outwards up to 600 kilometers from the center;

WHEREAS, per Situational Report No. 3 dated 28 July 2023, issued by the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office of the Municipality of Sadanga, Mountain Province, Typhoon Egay devastated the locality and affected 1,930 families and 8,933 individuals across the Barangays of Anabel, Bekigan, Belwang, Betwagan, Demang, Poblacion, Sarsacan and Saclit. The total estimated damages to the social, agricultural and infrastructure sectors of the said Municipality were at Ninety Million Five Hundred Seventy-Two Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-Eight Pesos (Php90,572,588.00);

WHEREAS, Quezon City established a Sisterhood Relationship with the Municipality of Sadanga, Mountain Province through Quezon City Council Resolution No. SP-2936, S-2005 entitled A Resolution Expressing the Desire to Establish a Sisterhood Relationship with Municipality of Sadanga, Mountain Province;

WHEREAS, the local government of Sadanga severely needs the City's urgent help in the immediate rehabilitation and restoration of its agricultural sector, particularly its rice paddies, as reiterated in a Letter dated 23 August 2023 from its Municipal Mayor, Hon. Adolf F. Ganggangan;

WHEREAS, in 2024, the Municipal Government of Sadanga actively consolidated and prepared all the necessary documentary requirements needed for the granting of financial assistance aimed at supporting the recovery and rehabilitation efforts of its locality;

WHEREAS, after careful review and verification, all required documents for evaluation and processing were duly completed and officially submitted to the Quezon City Government in December 2024;

WHEREAS, in January 2025, this Resolution was formally filed to provide the necessary authorization for the Quezon City Government to grant the financial assistance, ensuring support to Sadanga's recovery and rehabilitation;

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WHEREAS, Section 33 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides for the cooperative undertakings among Local Government Units by grouping themselves, consolidating or coordinating their efforts, services and resources for purposes commonly beneficial to them;

WHEREAS, under section 455 (b)(1)(v1) of the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED to extend, as it does hereby extend, financial assistance in the amount of Three Million Pesos (Php3,000,000.00) to the Municipal Government of Sadanga, Mountain Province due to the adverse impacts of Typhoon Egay (International Name: Doksuri) to fund the immediate rehabilitation and restoration of its agricultural sector, particularly its rice paddies, to wit:




